



Clear Channel Gives Crumbs to the Latino Community with New Show
NHMC Reaction Statement on Clear Channel's Announcement

PASADENA—(NHMC – Jan. 13, 2012)—Clear Channel (OTCBB: CCMO) has recently announced a new radio show on KTLK (1150) hosted by a Latino. The show will go up against “The John and Ken Show” on sister KFI AM 640. Clear Channel is dead wrong if they think that with these crumbs the campaign “Take John and Ken Off the Air” will stop.

“NHMC is pleased to hear that a Latino has a new radio show in the Los Angeles market, but this by no means ends the campaign against John and Ken,” stated Alex Nogales, NHMC President & CEO.

The same day that Clear Channel made its announcement, NHMC released its report “American Hate Radio” naming KFI, the station that broadcasts “The John and Ken Show”, “The Rush Limbaugh Show”, and “The Bill Handel Show” a hotspot for hate speech.
