Today the Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation held a hearing for President Biden's nomination of Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Acting Chairwoman Jessica Rosenworcel to permanently lead the Commission. Acting Chairwoman Rosenworcel is a champion of net neutrality, and a dedicated public servant who is passionate about closing the digital divide. The National Hispanic Media Coalition (NHMC) looks forward to continuing our work with Acting Chairwoman Rosenworcel to address the telecommunication needs of Latino community.

As the first woman President & CEO to lead NHMC, I am elated to see Acting Chairwoman Rosenworcel be nominated as Chair of the FCC. Earlier today NHMC sent a [letter](#) to Committee Chairwoman Maria Cantwell and Ranking Member Roger Wicker to urge for a quick confirmation vote and process in light of the Acting Chairwoman's leadership and advocacy in making internet access for Latinx households more equitable, affordable, and reliable.
